- Mouth guard, mitts & groin protector are mandatory.
- Mandatory head gear for youth divisions.
- Safety goggles or soft lenses only.
- Chest protector and shin guards are optional.

consideration of being allowed to participate in any way in the Riverside National Karate Championships and related events the undersigned:

Agrees that prior to participating, they know and understand the rules of the competition, and that they (If under 18 years of age a legal guardian) will inspect the facility and equipment to be used, and if the participant or guardian, believes anything is, or may be, unsafe, they will immediately advise their coach and the AJKA-I personnel of such condition(s) and refuse to participate unless and until such condition is remedied.

Acknowledges and fully understand that each participant will be engaging in activities that involve risk of serious injury, including permanent disability and death, and severe social and economic losses which might result not only from their own actions, inactions or negligence, but the actions, inactions or negligence of others. The rules of play or the condition of the premises or of any equipment used. Further that there may be other risks not known to us or not reasonably foreseeable at this time. The undersigned assumes all the foregoing risks and accepts personal responsibility for the damages following such an injury, including permanent disability or death.

Release, waive, discharge and covenant, not to sue AJKA-I, its officers, its affiliated clubs, regional sports organizations, their respective administrators, directors, agents, coaches, and other employees, staff, officials, and volunteers of the organizations, other participants, sponsoring agencies, sponsors, advertisers, and if applicable owners and lessees of premises used to conduct the event, all of which are here and after referred to as releasees, from any and all liability to each of the undersigned, his or her heirs, and next of kin, for any and all claims, demands, losses, or damages on account of injury including death or damage to property, caused by alleged to be caused in whole or in part by the negligence of the releasee or otherwise.
