	Mandatory protective equipment: Hand gloves, Mouth guard, protective cup				
Equipment	(male), chest protector (female). Safety glasses with restraining band will be				
	allowed for sparring. Head gear and Shin-instep guard allowed in 17 & under				
	divisions only. Competitor MUST have their own equipment.				
	Coaching will be allowed in Kumite ONLY.				
Coaching	 Dojo/Club track suit and Coaches Pass is MANDATORY.
