2020 AAU KARATE NY DISTRICT CHAMPIONSHIPS <u>COMPETITION FORMAT & RULES</u>

- ORDER OF EVENTS: Special Needs Division Will Begin at 9am Sharp!
 Followed By: All 18-34; 35+ male and female divisions
 All 5 & under; 6-7 & 8-9 year-old male and female divisions
 All 10-11 & 12-13 year-old male and female divisions
 All 14-15 & 16-17 year-old male and female divisions
- <u>RULES</u>: Modified AAU Rules: Kata Flag System, Shobu Sanbon Kumite, Kobudo (Scoring)
 ***Refer to <u>www.aaukarate.org</u> (Click on Rules then Karate Complete Rules)

- KUMITE: **Shobu Sanbon for all Divisions** (Wazari: 1/2 point, Ippon: 1 full point)
 - 18-34 Advanced: 2 minutes
 - All other Adult divisions & Ages 12-17: 1 ½ minutes
 - 11 and under: 1 minute
 - All Matches are Stop Time.
 - 3 Full Points (6 Wazari) wins bout
 - Ties decided in Enchosen (Extended match in which first score wins)
 - o **SCORING:** A full point (Ippon) is awarded for: (1) controlled kick to the head/face or (2) break of balance / safe takedown immediately followed by a scoring technique.
 - All other techniques to scoring areas will be awarded ½ Point (Wazari)
 - PENALTY CATEGORIES: (1) Hansoku Prohibited actions and behaviors, including Contact and non-contact penalties; (2) Jogai Out of bounds
 - (3) Mubobi defenseless behavior.
 - (4) Shikkaku (disqualification or expulsion from the event/competition)
 - PENALTY LEVELS: Each Penalty Category has 3 levels:
 - (1) Chukoku (warning), (2) Hansoku Chui (penalty), (3) Hansoku (disqualification)
- **FACE CONTACT: For <u>Beginner and Novice</u> Divisions (kick/hand technique): Face contact is prohibited and may be penalized. Skin touch (kick) to side/back of head is permitted.
 - *For <u>Intermediate and Advanced Divisions</u> (kick/hand technique): "skin touch" is permitted, but transfer of energy to the face area is prohibited and will be penalized.

2020 AAU KARATE NY DISTRICT CHAMPIONSHIPS COMPETITION FORMAT & RULES

KATA: **Flag System Utilized for All Divisions**

** All Divisions May Repeat Kata Through the Final Round (Except 18-34 Advanced)

** 18-34 Advanced Must Perform a Different Kata in Each Round (Bracket Format)

AAU RULES: Beginner: Must Perform Basic Kata Only

Novice: May Perform Basic/Intermediate Level Kata

Intermediate: May perform any kata Advanced: May Perform any Kata

- KOBUDO: **Numerical Scoring System;
 - In the event of a tie, the competitors may perform the same kobudo kata, EXCEPT in an Advanced Division. To break a tie in an advanced division, the competitors must perform a different kata (it may be a different weapon).
 - In a combined Intermediate and Advanced division, competitors may perform the same kata, in the event of a tie.
- **TEAM KATA:** *All three team members must start and end the Kata facing in the same direction and towards the Referee.
 - They shall start and finish in a triangular formation.
 - All three members shall perform the same kata.
 - The performance must be synchronized.
 - Team Kata uses the individual scoring system with the winner being the contestant (team) with the highest total score.
 - One round of competition shall determine the winners in team kata.
- <u>SPECIAL NEEDS DIVISION:</u> Competitors in this division may choose to compete in Kata,
 Kumite, and/or Kobudo. If applicable, Competition shall be
 Divided by Age, Rank and Gender. We may combine categories
 To create a competitive division.
