Team Kata

will be divided by Rank and Age category but will be combined as needed. Point system will be utilized for this event.

All competitors must compete in the same age and level for kata and kumite.

Kata

- <u>Beginners</u> (0-1 year of training; 7th kyu or below) <u>& Novice</u> (1-2 years of training; 6th to 4th kyu) Heian/Pinan/Gekisai etc. May repeat Kata.
- Intermediate (3-4 years of training; 3rd to 1st kyu) Any choice kata to match their level. May repeat Kata.
- **Advanced** (4 years or more of training; Shodan and above) can perform any Kata.
- Age 17 & under MUST perform a different kata in Medal round.
- Age 18 and older CANNOT REPEAT KATA FLAG SYSTEM WILL BE UTILIZED.

Kumite Shobu Sanbon

COACHING WILL BE ALLOWED IN KUMITE – COACHES PASS - \$30.00 MUST WEAR CLUB TRACK SUIT

Modified AJKA-I/AAU rules: light head contact is permitted for Adult black belts only

Uncontrolled techniques will result in penalty or disqualification

All divisions will run 1:30 minute stop time

18-34 Black Belt kumite will run 2 minutes, stop time.

All matches Shobu Sanbon

Competitors must have all mandatory equipment: mouthguard, fist guards, groin protector (men), headgear (17 and under) foot pads that cover toes.

Competitor MUST provide their own equipment

In the spirit of karate-do, proper conduct is required from competitors and instructors alike, or else suspension will result from all future AJKA-I/ Bucks County Karate School events.
